Apprenticeship Training Program	DOL certified apprenticeship program meets Davis-Bacon Act requirements Program locations: Atlanta, Columbus, Valdosta, Savannah. Online live webcast with integrated labs and proctored exams throughout US. DOL journeyman card issued upon completion (good in all 50 states)
Advanced Electricians Training	The Professional Electricians Program (PEP) is an online two-year program for journeyman that have the field knowledge, but lack formal training. Topics include: Motor Controls, Code Fundamentals, Theory, Blueprint Reading, Leadership. Meets the Davis-Bacon requirements. Journeyman Card Issued.
Continuing Education	All classes and seminars meet GA Licensing requirements. Most NEC Code classes meet CEU requirements in AL, VA, NC (KY, FL, TX coming in 2014)
Loan/Borrow Program	Loan or borrow workers from/to other IEC members locally, state, and nationally
Hire New Helpers/Apprentices	IEC maintains a database of qualified helpers and apprentices for employment
